We support human rights-based approaches to tackling homelessness.

The Homeless Bill of Rights is a compilation of basic human rights drawn from international and regional human rights instruments specific to the situation of homeless people. Local authorities should work for the progressive realization of the right to adequate housing as part of the obligation to guarantee an adequate standard of living for all people.

We encourage local authorities in England to reaffirm their commitment to respect the rights of people experiencing homelessness by adopting the Homeless Bill of Rights.

- Equal treatment for all
- An effective postal address
- Access basic sanitary facilities
- Emergency services
- Vote
