Our 5 principles

1. Rights **knowledge**: about the rights themselves, and the structures and processes that relate to them
2. Rights **frameworks**: to implement them into domestic law and incorporate them into day-to-day life
3. Rights **resourcing**: of the rights substantively and on a proactive basis to ensure the best use of available resources
4. Rights **accountability**: so that mechanisms work well in practice and routes to remedy are effective and lead to real and sustainable change
5. Rights **enjoyment**: and protection of rights will be an ongoing process of learning, evaluation, reflection and progressive change
